

Guidelines for the John E. Trott, Jr. Award in Student Recruiting

In determining the recipient of this award, the following guidelines will be adhered to:

- 1. A call for nominations will be distributed at least six weeks prior to the presentation of the award. This award is presented at the discretion of the school and as such, may not necessarily be presented each year. Honorees will be recognized at the School of Education and Human Development's *Fall Kick-Off Luncheon* held on **August 15, 2023,** in the **TAMU MSC Bethancourt Ballroom.**
- **2.** Eligible individuals must **not** be currently employed by the School of Education and Human Development.
- **3.** The recipient must be/have been a significant representation of the university and/or the School of Education and Human Development's undergraduate and/or graduate student recruitment efforts to be eligible for nomination.
- 4. The recipient must demonstrate outstanding accomplishments, such as:
 - Volunteerism with recruitment programs
 - Representation of the school beyond normal assigned duties
 - Positive influence on prospective students
- 5. Nominations can be submitted by any individual with first-hand knowledge of the nominee's contribution to the school's undergraduate and/or graduate student recruitment efforts. The nomination packet <u>may not exceed eight pages</u> and should include the nomination form, a CV/resume, a nomination letter and no more than two letters of support (please note, letters may not exceed two pages).
- 6. Nomination letters should be addressed to the John E. Trott, Jr. Award in Student Recruiting Selection Committee
- 7. The recipient will receive a plaque for the **John E. Trott, Jr. Award in Student Recruiting** and two complimentary lunch reservations at the *Fall Kick-Off Luncheon*.
- **8.** Recipients of this award are eligible for nomination again after five (5) years.
- 9. Nomination packets are to be sent to Wendy Kreider at wkreider@tamu.edu by June 1, 2023. Only complete nomination packets will be forwarded to the selection committee for consideration.
